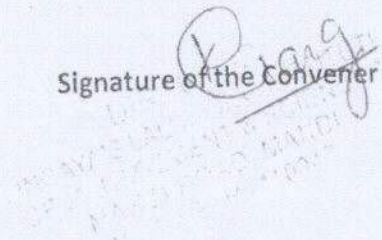



Brief Summary of the National Seminar on Emerging Trends in the Business Environment


