Noise Pollution Talks

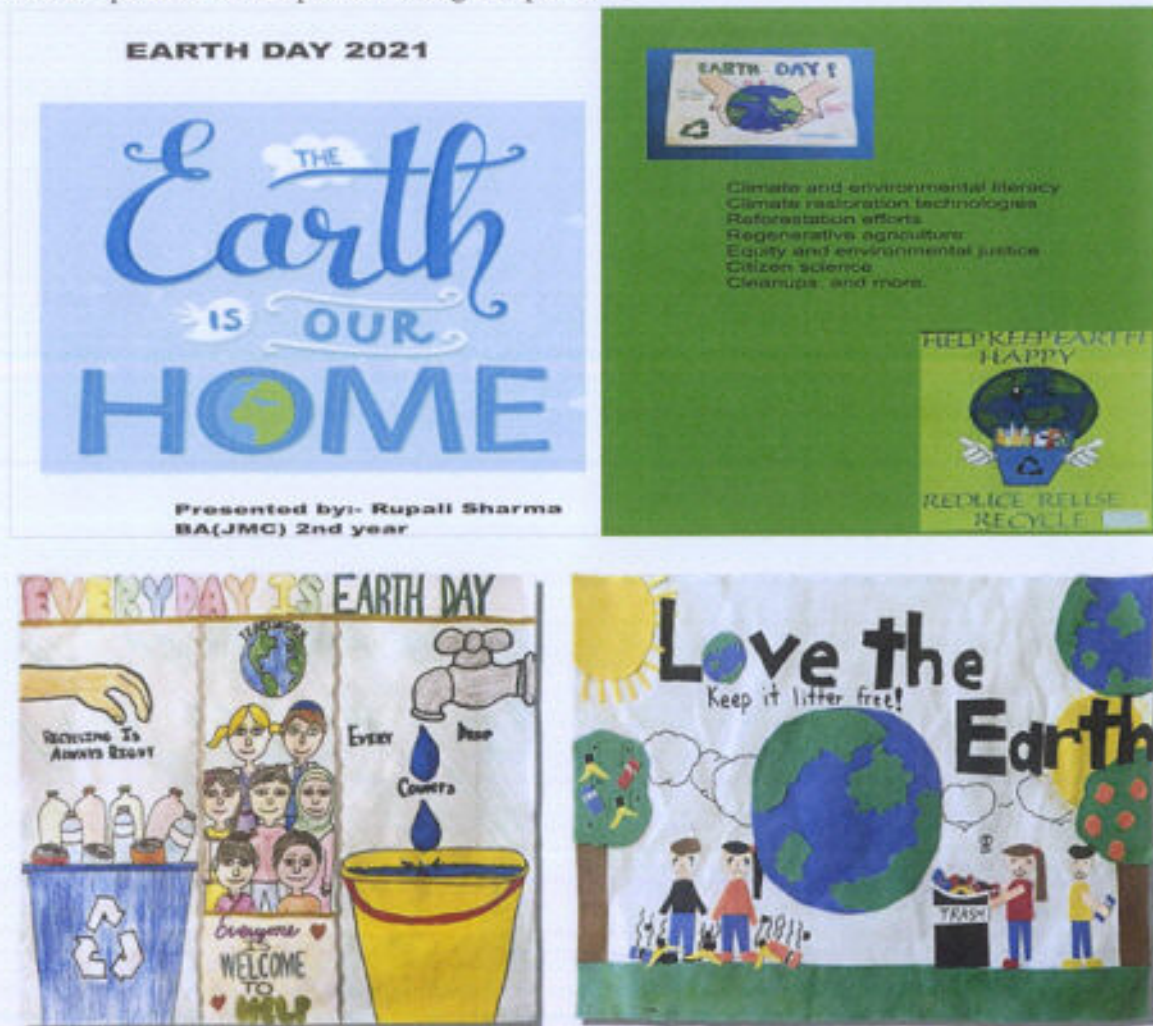

E- Activity on International Energy Conservation Day



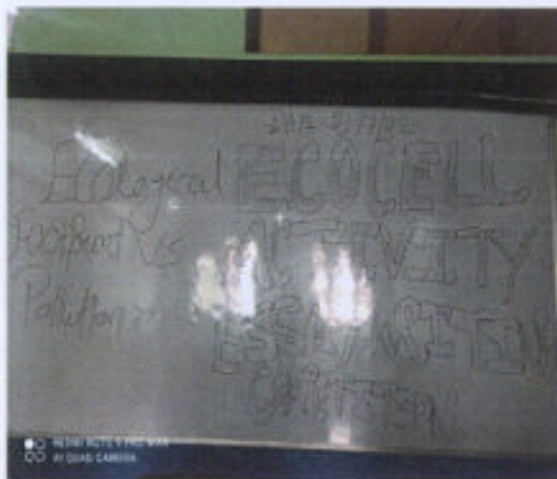
Ecological Footprint Vs Pollution
