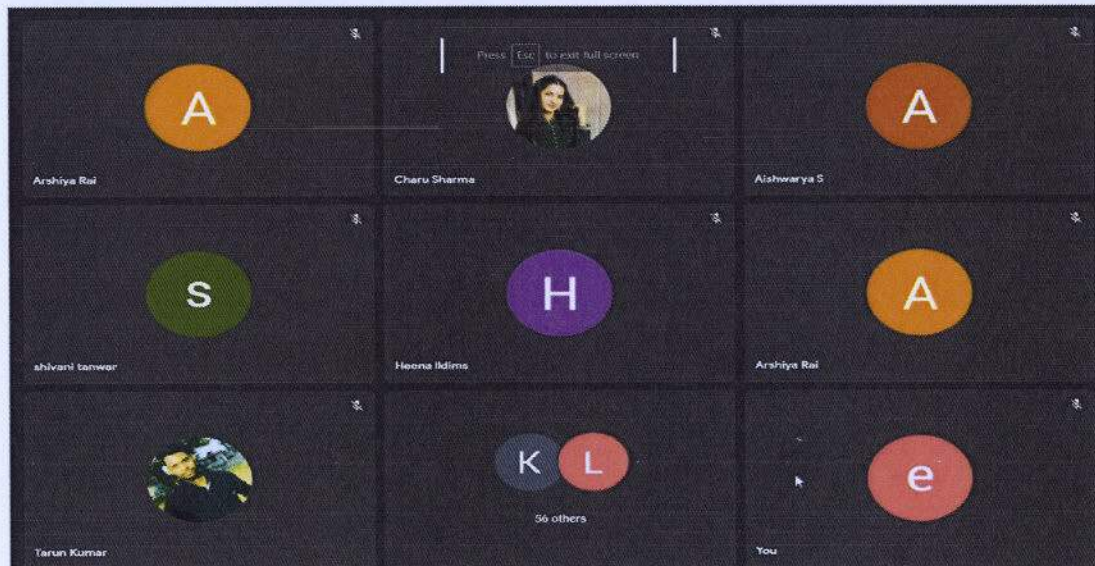
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**E workshop on getting to your Dream B-school 1/8/2021 ,Ms. Ishika Goyal Alumni IIM Kolkata**

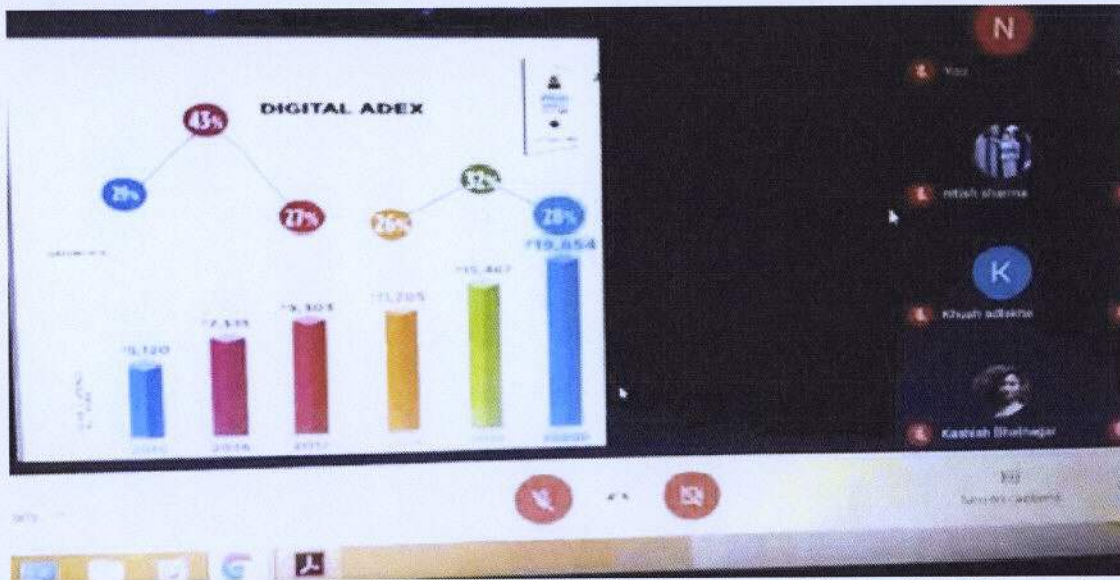

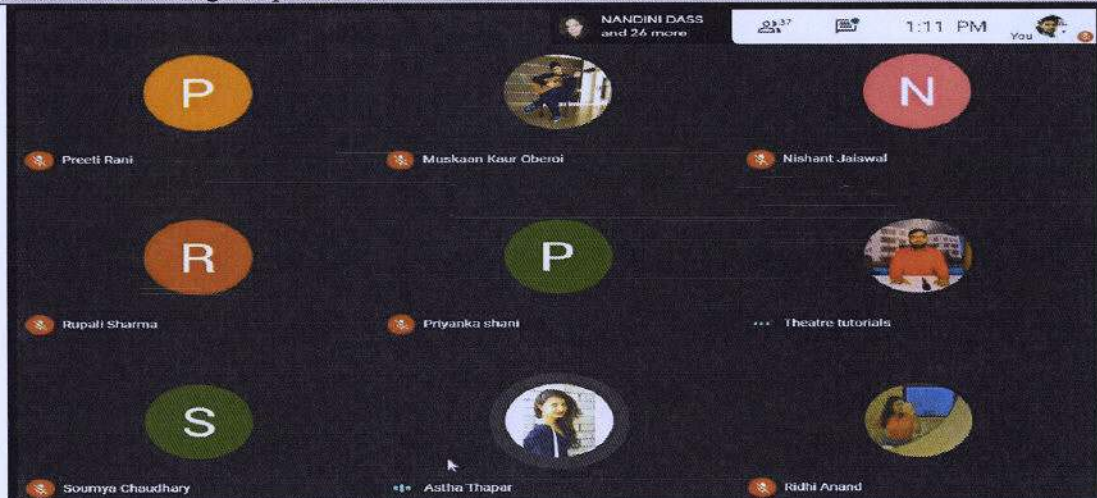

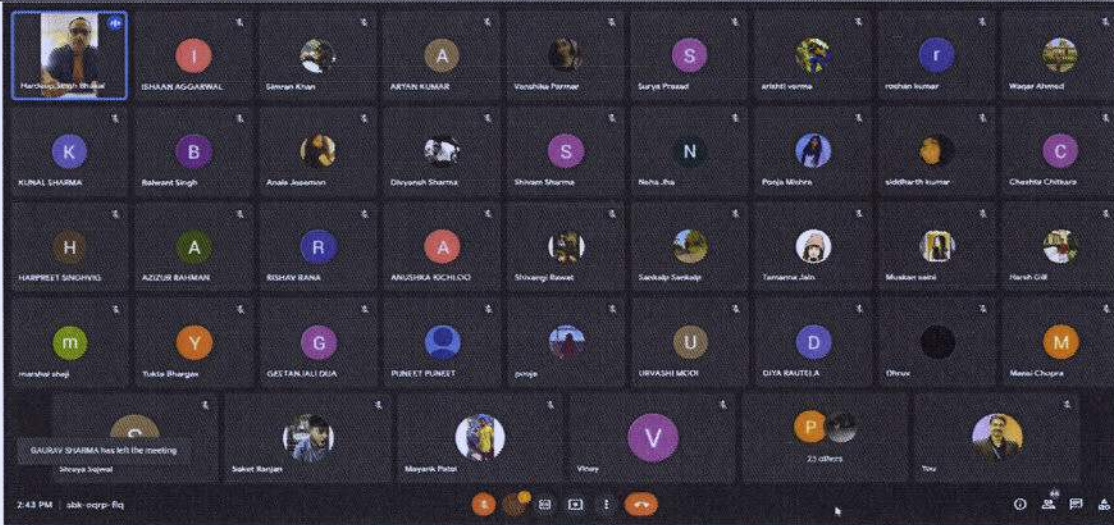
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**Guest Lecture, Micro Teaching 3/9/2021, Dr. Parveshlata Department of Education**


### Intra college Debate competition on the topic of Impact of social networking on the development of our society 5-Feb-2021

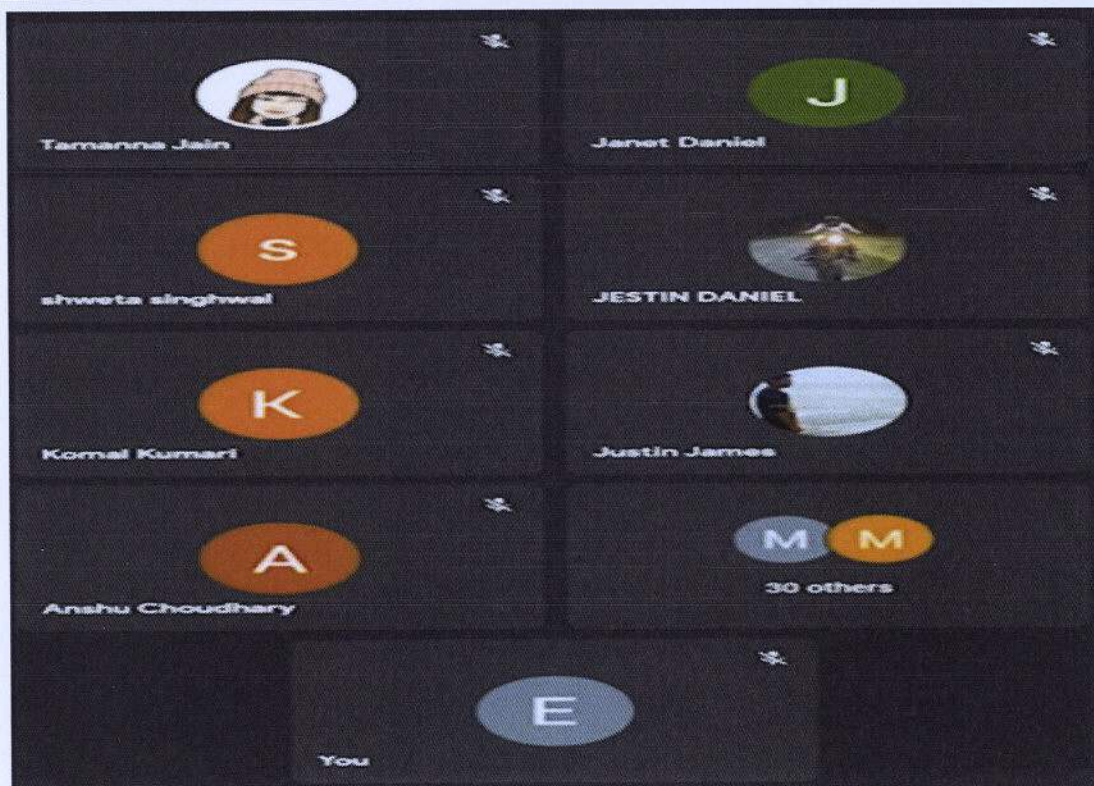
  
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### E workshop on Gratitude Therapy, 3/3/2021

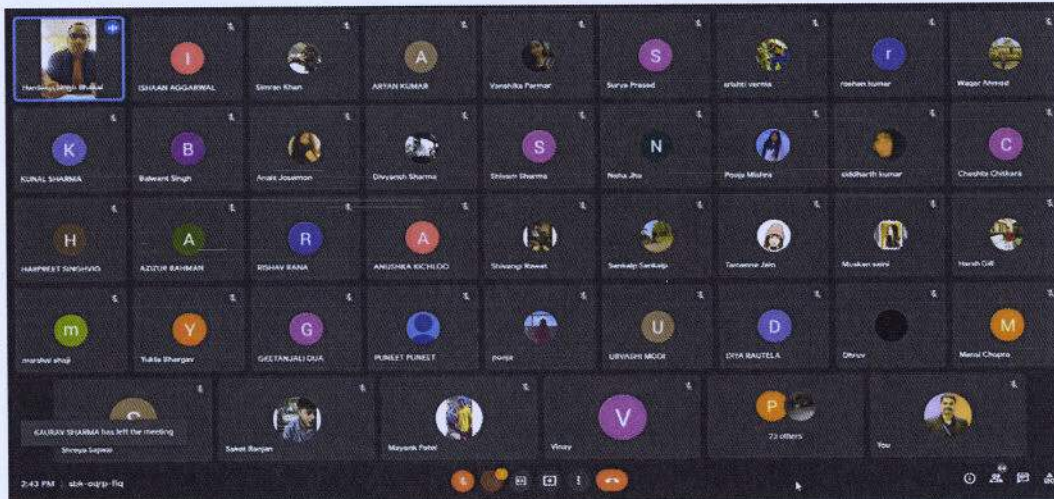
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**Debate Competition 5/2/2021, Debating Society-LLDIMS Department of BAJMC**

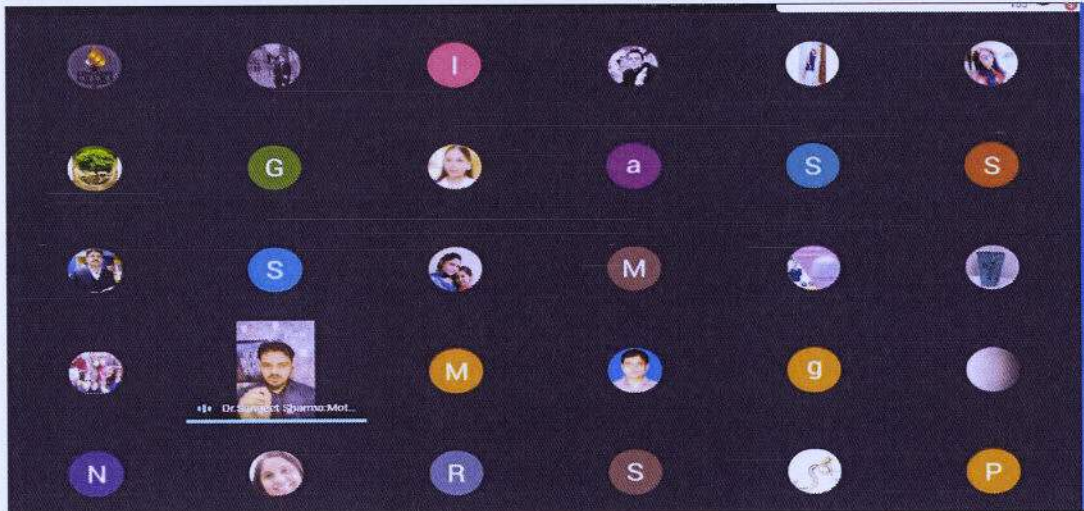

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

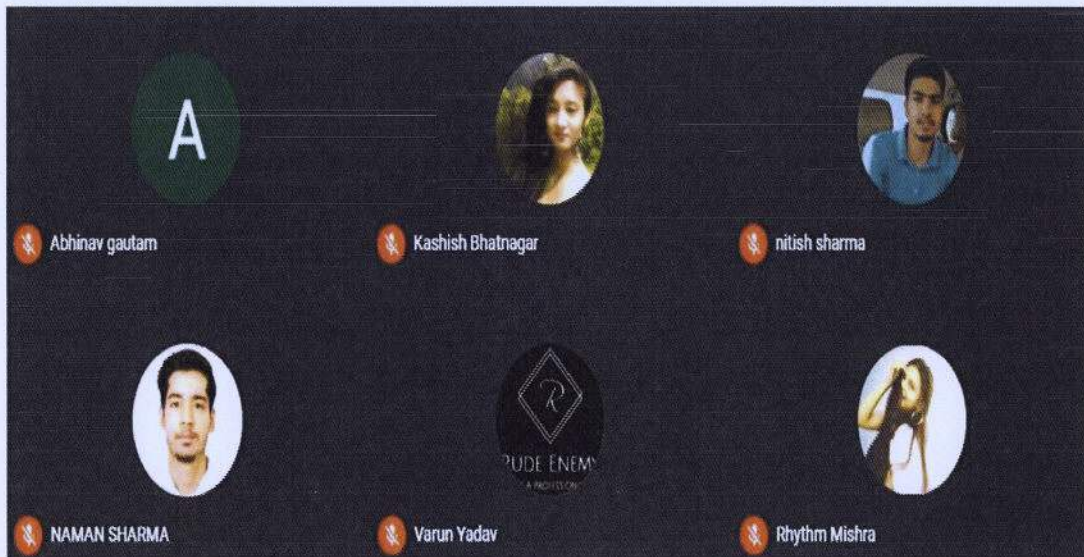
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### Webinar on Cancer Awareness 4/2/2021 ,AIESEC

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
### Virtual Yoga Session 21/06/2021

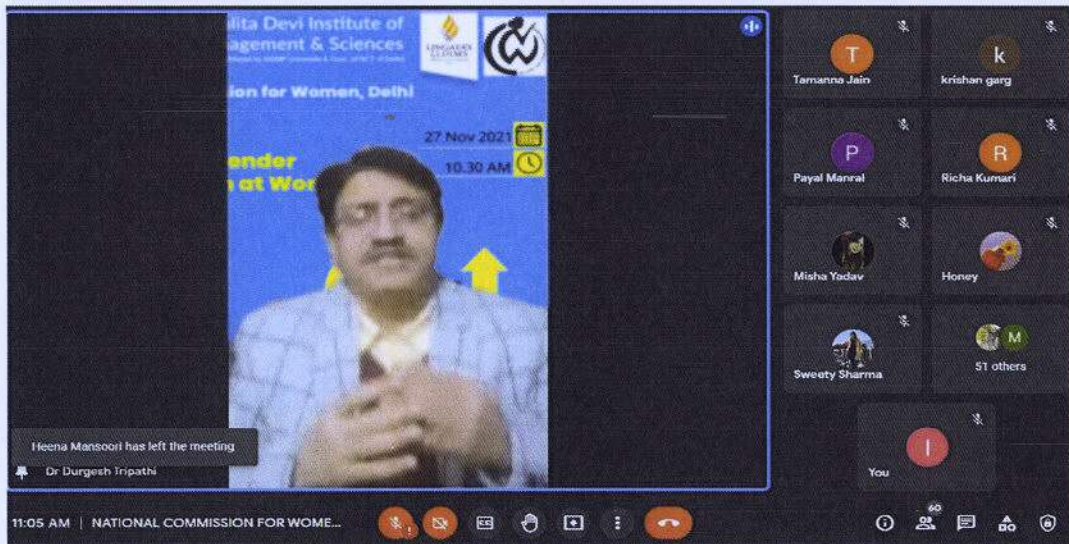
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**E Workshop on Gender Discrimination at Workplace by National Commission for Women, Delhi 27/12/2021 80 Dr. DurgeshTripathi**
