Upon receiving a complaint through the Women Community Extension Cell at LLDIMS, the following action process is typically undertaken:

- Documentation\*: The complaint is documented, detailing the nature of the concern, date, and relevant details.
- Review and Analysis\*: The complaint undergoes a thorough review and analysis to understand its context and severity.
- \*Consultation with Parties\*: Depending on the nature of the complaint, the cell may consult with involved parties, gather additional information, and assess the situation.
- Conflict Resolution or Support\*: The cell may initiate conflict resolution processes or provide necessary support services to address the issue, ensuring the well-being of the individuals involved.
- Disciplinary Actions\*: If required, appropriate disciplinary actions may be taken in accordance with the institution's policies and guidelines.

6Follow-up and Monitoring\*: The cell monitors the resolution process, conducting follow-ups to ensure that the issue has been effectively addressed and preventive measures are in place.

 Feedback and Closure\*: Feedback is sought from the complainant, and the case is closed after ensuring satisfactory resolution and preventive measures for future occurrences.

This structured process aims to handle complaints in a fair, confidential, and timely manner, fostering a safe and supportive environment within the community.

All the faculty members praised the program on this occasion.




