India became the fourth nation to land on the Moon and the first to reach this unexplored area. The 2024 theme, "Touching Lives while Touching the Moon: India's Space Saga," emphasizes the impact of space exploration on daily life. Recent findings from Chandrayaan-3 revealed uniform terrain and support the lunar magma ocean (LMO) hypothesis, shedding light on the Moon's crust formation and mineral composition.
