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
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INSPIRING YOU



MR. RAGHU RAI

Raghu Rai is a renowned Indian photographer and photojournalist known for his impactful and evocative images that capture the essence of Indian life, culture, and significant historical moments. Born on December 18, 1942, in Jhang, British India (now in Pakistan), Raghu Rai is celebrated as one of the pioneers of Indian photography. Rai was awarded the Padmashree in 1971, one of India's highest civilian awards ever given to a photographer. In 1992, his National Geographic cover story Human Management of Wildlife in India won him widespread critical acclaim for the piece.



Raghu Rai started his career as a civil engineer but transitioned into photography in the early 1960s after being inspired by his elder brother, S. Paul, also a noted photographer.

In 1966, Rai joined The Statesman newspaper in New Delhi as a photojournalist. His work quickly gained recognition for its depth and unique perspective.


His photographs have been featured in leading global publications like Time, Life, The New York Times, The Guardian, and National Geographic.

Raghu Rai's photographs are a blend of realism and artistry, often focusing on capturing the human spirit amid societal and cultural contexts. His ability to document emotions and tell stories visually has made him an influential figure in contemporary photography.

His work is studied for its profound narrative ability, sharp composition, and evocative use of light and shadow.


Awards and Honors:-

- National Geographic Cover Stories: His work has been a recurring feature in the prestigious magazine.











PHOTOGRAPHY TIPS & TRICKS

Types of shots:

1. Wide Shot (WS):

A wide shot captures the subject and their environment in a single frame. It's often used to showcase landscapes, architecture, or a subject's relationship to their surroundings.

2. Medium Shot (MS):

Medium shots frame the subject from the waist up, focusing on both the person and their immediate environment. These shots are great for portraits or lifestyle photography, balancing personal detail with background elements to create a natural, relatable composition.

3. Close-Up (CU):

Close-ups focus on a specific part of the subject, such as the face, hands, or an object.

4. Extreme Close-Up (ECU):

An extreme close-up zooms in even further, emphasizing tiny details like an eye, a droplet of water, or the texture of fabric.

5. Low-Angle Shot:


Low-angle shots are taken from below, looking up at the subject. They create a sense of power or grandeur, making them ideal for dramatic portraits, towering structures, or unique artistic perspectives.

6. High-Angle Shot:

Taken from above, high-angle shots make the subject appear smaller or more vulnerable. They're often used in creative compositions to emphasize patterns, symmetry, or a unique viewpoint.

Macro Shot:


Macro shots focus on extreme close-up details of small subjects, like insects, flowers, or textures.
