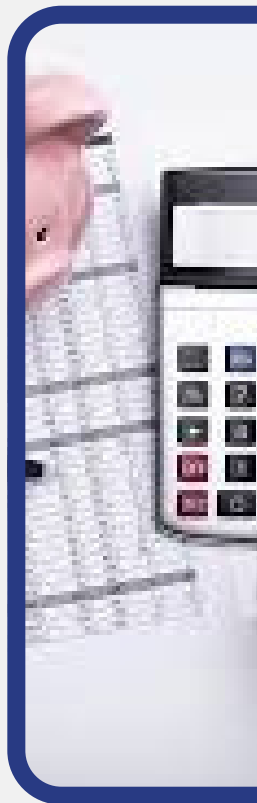


ABOUT THE SEMINAR
