


## ABriefReport on First National Space Day





## REPORT ON CLEAN & GREEN ENVIRONMENT

Overall, the discussion highlighted the need for a multifaceted approach to managing noise risks, combining preventive measures, protective equipment, and policy enforcement.




## Report on Poster-Making Competition on Noise Pollution






### Poetry Recitation:
