TRANSPORT FEE STRUCTURE FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2026–27

This is to inform all students that the following Transport Fees will be applicable for the Academic Session 2026–27 w.e.f. **01 July 2026**:

Upto Chattarpur	:	Rs. 17,000/- per annum
Upto 15 kms.	:	Rs. 30,000/- per annum
15 kms to 25 kms	:	Rs. 36,000/- per annum
Beyond 25 kms.	:	Rs. 40,000/- per annum.

Important Instructions:

- 1 All buses are fully Air-Conditioned.
- 2 Bus routes will be finalized as per students' requirements.
- 3 Transport fee up to Rs. 20,000/- shall be deposited in one installment only.
- 4 Transport fee above Rs. 20,000/- may be deposited in two installments.

The meeting of the Transport Committee was held on 2nd August 2025 at 12:00 PM in the Board Room to discuss the following key points:

1. Operation of College Buses & Student Convenience:

Discussions were held regarding the number of buses to be operated. It was emphasized that efforts must be made to ensure students are encouraged to use college transport and reach the campus on time.

2. Finalisation of Bus Routes:

Only those routes will be finalized where a minimum of 25–30 students are confirmed to be commuting from longer distances. The aim is to ensure route feasibility and optimize bus usage.

3. Promotion of Bus Facilities:

It was agreed that active steps must be taken to promote the use of college buses among students through orientation, awareness drives, and regular communication.

4. Collective Responsibility:

All committee members and concerned staff are jointly responsible for ensuring that students are informed about the transport facilities and are encouraged to avail them.

5. Accountability of Committee Members:

During the admission process, committee members will be asked to report the efforts made by them towards promoting transport services, the number of students they have assisted, and how many students are currently availing the college bus facility.

The meeting concluded with a mutual understanding that proactive efforts are required to improve the reach and efficiency of college transport.
