

List of Scholarship scheme available for LLDIMS students

1. GGSIPU Economically Weaker Section (EWS) Financial Assistance Scheme

- For students from economically weaker families.
- Financial assistance is provided towards tuition fees.
- Applications are invited annually through the Directorate of Students' Welfare (DSW).
- Document verification and personal interaction are part of the selection process.

2. Merit-cum-Means Linked Financial Assistance Scheme

- For meritorious students with financial need.
- Managed through the Delhi Higher Education Aid Trust.
- Assistance is based on academic performance and family income.

3. Delhi Higher & Technical Education Support Scheme

- Delhi Government scholarship for deserving students pursuing higher education.
- Covers eligible students studying in participating Delhi institutions.
- Thousands of students across Delhi universities, including GGSIPU, have benefited.

4. Delhi Government e-District Scholarships

Available for eligible Delhi residents:

- Post Matric Scholarship for SC Students
- Post Matric Scholarship for OBC Students (PMS-OBC)
- Merit Scholarship for SC/ST/OBC students
- Merit Scholarship for Minority students
- Single Girl Child Scholarship (where applicable under notified schemes)
- B.R. Ambedkar State Topper Award

5. National Scholarship Portal (NSP) Schemes

Students can also apply through the National Scholarship Portal for:

- Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship (CSSS)
- Merit-cum-Means Scholarship for Minority Students
- Post Matric Scholarship for Minorities
- Prime Minister's Scholarship Scheme
- Scholarships for wards of Defence Personnel/CAPF
- Other Ministry-sponsored scholarships based on eligibility.

6. AICTE Scholarships (for eligible professional courses)

Students enrolled in AICTE-approved programmes may apply for:

- Pragati Scholarship (Girls)
- Saksham Scholarship (Students with Disabilities)
- Swanath Scholarship (Special categories such as orphans and wards of certain personnel)

7. Private & Institutional Scholarships

GGSIU also lists or facilitates applications for certain institutional scholarships, including:

- DLF Scholarship
- Hana Scholarship
- Entrepreneurship Development Programme (EDP) Financial Assistance

Documents generally required

- Aadhaar Card
- Income Certificate
- Caste/EWS/Minority certificate (if applicable)
- Previous year's mark sheet
- Fee receipt

- Bank account details
- Passport-size photograph

Besides, LLDIMS offers Various other types of scholarships on the basis of:

-IPU CET Rank, CUET Score, Class 12th Boards score (up to 100 % scholarship)
