AI BOOT CAMP: EXPLORING, LEARNING AND INNOVATING WITH ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

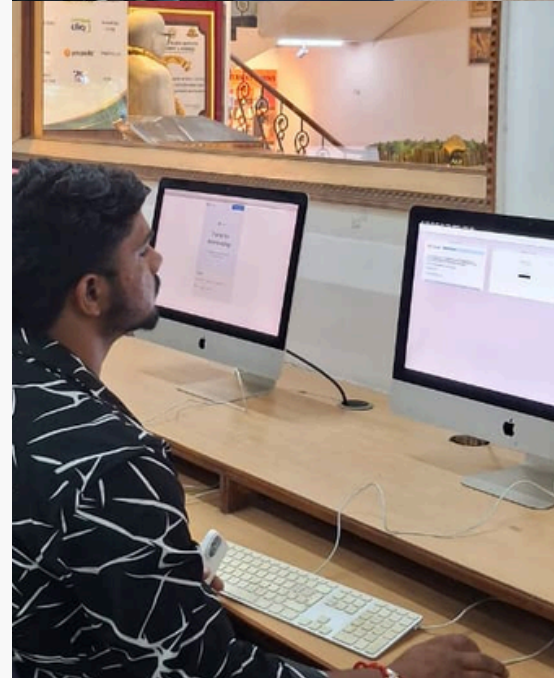
